2017 Highlights

- One of the Phaeton Dr entrance signs was hit by a car in April. The insurance company of the driver at fault paid for the damage, and the HOA oversaw the installation of a new sign.
- The City of Mobile completed the addition of concrete medians on Cottage Hill Rd at Royal Carriage Dr in October.
- The large azalea bushes at the lower end of the Royal Carriage Dr. median were cut back due to being overgrown, and choked with vines and small trees. Also, the shrubs at the Phaeton Dr entrance, which made it difficult for exiting drivers to see oncoming traffic, were replaced with ground cover.
- An upturn in burglaries and break-ins in the neighborhood caused much concern, leading to a special meeting in October with Mobile Police Chief Battiste and Councilwoman Rich.
